Charles Krebs has also been confirmed as a keynote speaker sharing his latest findings on acupuncture formatting!



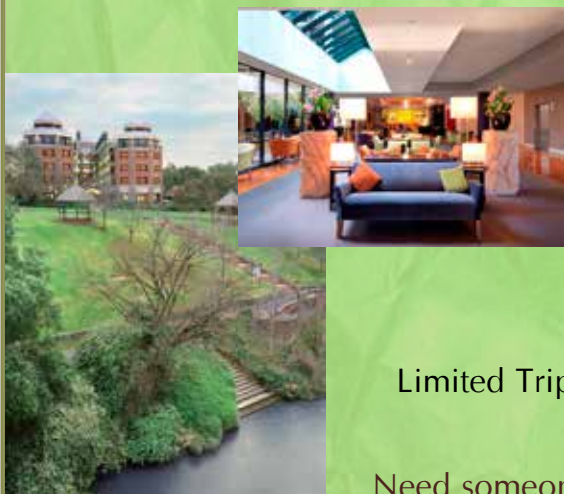
Mini Workshops will be held on Friday morning and early afternoon and presented by the vibrant Kathy Carmuciano and Robbi Zeck. See details on following page.
